This past year opened the door to exciting new opportunities for First Tee Gulf Coast participants—both on and off the course. Just last month, four outstanding young golfers—Mobile's Jasmine Nguyen, Shalimar's Mason Dean Hampton, Niceville's Tenley Sharron, and Gulf Breeze's Michelle Burt—were selected to represent our chapter at the First Tee Greater New Orleans Invitational Tournament.

Despite it being the first appearance for all four, they rose to the challenge and successfully defended the overall team title by just one shot. Tenley captured the girls' title, while Mason Dean finished runner-up in the boys' division—also by a single shot. Their performance reflected not only talent, but preparation, teamwork, and composure.

Another highlight came from Abby Vernier of West Florida High School, one of our brightest young leaders. A year after representing First Tee Gulf Coast at Pebble Beach, Abby was selected for a new national First Tee Participant Opportunity—Indigo and Gopher—held at South Carolina's Ohoopee Match Club. There, she connected with participants from across the country and returned home with unforgettable stories of camaraderie, competition—and even zebras on the course. She also earned a financial support for future education and playing expenses. As Abby described it, along with Pebble Beach, it was *another experience of a lifetime*. These are the opportunities First Tee opens up for our participants with strong golf skills and character who remain engaged in the program.

This past year also brought a moment of reflection with the loss of Coach Rod Kelley (pictured middle), a beloved mentor, leader, and friend. A Pensacola native



and Air Force veteran, Rod lived a life of service as an ordained minister, civics teacher, corrections officer, and marriage counselor. In 2013, he helped launch our Okaloosa/Walton programs at Fort Walton Beach Golf Club and went on to build a coaching family that expanded to four additional sites. At our first meeting, while discussing the Nine Core Values, Coach Rod said, "I've been looking for a program like this my entire life." He is survived by his wife of more than 56 years, Coach Jorja, and by the thousands of young people whose lives he impacted.

As we look ahead, we hope this spring is the season more families discover that while being great at golf is a worthy goal, living the core values can make a young person a **Game Changer for life**. To all of those like Coach Rod who passionately care to invest in and improve our youth—thank you for all you do to shape the next generation of leaders.

Coaches Corner

One of the most rewarding parts of being a First Tee coach is watching players discover what they are capable of, not just on the golf course, but in how they approach challenges, setbacks, and success in everyday life. While our weekly Golf and Life Skills classes provide a strong foundation, some of the most meaningful growth happens when those lessons continue at home in simple, fun ways.

Two of the Five Key Commitments we emphasize at First Tee Gulf Coast are **Growing Through Challenges** and **Building a Positive Self-Identity**. These commitments show up on the course when kids persevere after a tough shot or gain confidence from small improvements. Golf is a game where no one plays perfectly, not even the professionals, so learning to keep trying and believe in themselves is just as important as learning proper technique. When kids see that effort and a positive mindset lead to progress, they begin to feel proud of who they are, both in golf and in life.

A great way to reinforce both golf skills and Life Skills at home is through short, fun practice challenges. These activities do not need to be complicated or time-consuming. Just 10 to 15 minutes in the backyard, at a park, or even in the living room can make a big difference.

Try this simple activity: place three objects on the ground (cups, water bottles, or small cones, etc.). Have your child use a club or plastic putter to roll a ball toward each target. The goal isn't perfection, but effort and improvement. Encourage your child to say something positive out loud after each attempt, such as, "I can do this," or "I'm getting better!"

Misses are a great opportunity to practice perseverance. Encourage your child to take a breath and try again or turn it into a game by rewarding effort and positive attitude instead. Another fun option is a family challenge—let your child teach you what they learned in class. Laugh together, make mistakes together, and celebrate small wins.

The more kids experience golf as fun and encouraging, the more likely they are to keep playing and improving. Every small practice helps build habits that support success on the course and in life!
