

First Tee FAQs Answered

How do you build character through golf?

- Like in life, golf requires goal setting, working with others and digging deep when things get tough (perseverance). Golf is a perfect practice ground for learning skills that go far beyond the fairways.

What if my child has never picked up a golf club before?

- Our coaches are trained in creating a supportive environment to make kids feel comfortable and assure they have fun while learning about themselves and golf.

Where do we meet for class?

- Near the practice putting green unless otherwise specified.

Does my participant need golf clubs?

- For those who do not have clubs, we will provide any equipment that is needed. For information on loaner sets and new sets please email us at contactus@firstteegulfcoast.org.

What should my participant wear to class?

- Golf attire with golf or athletic shoes is recommended at all locations. For more details, please view our full [Dress Code](#) on our website.

What should we bring?

- Bring a water bottle and sunscreen on warm days, and if your participant has clubs, please feel free to bring them.



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What form of communication do we use during the session?

- Email is the preferred use for all communication regarding your specific class. Please make sure to check it often for notifications from your Lead Coach.

As a parent or guardian, what should I expect or do during class?

- At the Ages 5–6 level, we recommend that a parent or guardian remain at the facility throughout class. Should your participant need something, (i.e. to use the restroom) we prefer the parents to assist the participant. Parents with participants who are over 7 are welcome to stay and observe, but it is not required.

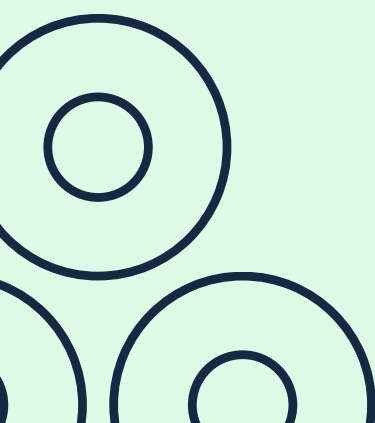
Are parents or guardians allowed to participate in class?

What if my participant is going to miss a class?

How do we know if class is cancelled due to weather?

- Your Lead Coach will notify everyone via email for all weather cancellations in a timely manner.
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Are there make-ups if there is a weather cancellation?

If my participant cannot attend a class, can they attend a different class during the week as a make-up?

- No. Participants are only allowed to attend the class in which they are registered for.

What is included in the annual membership?

- With their membership, each participant receives a First Tee member card which allows for special [discounts and benefits](#) at partner courses, local businesses and more! These cards are mailed out to participants.
